4. MARKINGS

4.1 Rally start numbers and shields

Location

The organizer will provide the start numbers and rally shields to each crew at the administrative check. All markings must be placed in prescribed places before the technical scrutineering. Starting numbers must be placed on the side door of the vehicle, rally shield will be placed prominently on the front of the car (can't obscure the registration plate). The motorcycles will be solved individually.

On the car cannot be placed another starting number than of Oldtimer Bohemia Rally 2021. In case of violation of this regulation, the crew will not be permitted to start the Oldtimer Bohemia Rally 2021. After finding out, these regulation were violated, the crew will be excluded immediately.

4.2 Identification of persons

Marking of the competitors will be done with a card with the inscription "DRIVER", which will be provided by the organizer. The marking of officials will be done with a card with "DIRECTORATE, ORGANIZER", etc., or the function they perform.

5. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECK

5.1 Documents to present

Application confirmation
Driver's license
Identification card (ID card), if the competitor is registered in the FIVA category
Proof of vehicle insurance
Vehicle documents

6. TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING

6.1 Time of technical scrutineering

The time for the technical acceptance will be determined upon confirmation of the application. Each vehicle must carry valid registration plate or special registration plate and must be technically eligible for use on the roads in ČR. If not so, the vehicle will not come through the technical check.

7. PARKING

7.1 Parking of competition vehicles

Night parking will be provided for rally vehicles in the guarded parking house Jaselská.

8. RALLY PROCEDURE

8.1 Start rally

The start of the rally will be on Thursday, September 02, 2021. Starting interval for all competition days is 1 minute. Crews will arrive to the starting zone 3 minutes before their prescribed time.

8.2 Arrival at the finish of the stage

Early arrival at the destination at break points (lunch time) is not allowed. Early arrival at the destination of each day is allowed.

After passing the finish line of the day, the crew will leave according to the organizers' instructions

12. IMPORTANT INFORMATION

12.1 Traffic regulations

Act No. 226/2006 Coll. governs traffic on roads in the Czech Republic.

Here we present a selection of important provisions:

- While driving a motor vehicle, the crew is always obliged to use seat belts, if the vehicle is equipped with them.
- The driver is prohibited from using a mobile phone or other means of communication while driving.
- The driver must not consume alcohol or other narcotic substances before and during the ride, in the Czech Republic there is a zero limit on the content of these substances in the body.
- Pedestrians have priority over vehicles at marked crossings.
- While driving on the highway the car must be equipped with toll sticker.
- On the roads in the Czech Republic, the year-round use of side and dipped beam headlights or daytime running lights is ordered, if the vehicle is equipped with them.
- Speed is limited as follows:
- in the village at 50 km/h
- outside the village 90 km/h
- $\bullet\,$ on the highway 130 km/h

13. RALLY RULES

OLDTIMER BOHEMIA RALLY 2021 is run as an "international FIVA regularity competition". The track runs on roads open for public operation. The rally is organized in accordance with the international technical and sports code FIVA.

Competitors complete the course according to the itinerary in compliance with the time limit or according to the map. **Unless there is another sign in the itinerary, always follow the main road or go straight on the crossroad.**

Official notice board at the time of the rally placed in the area headquarters rally, Mladá Boleslav. All competitors are **obliged to follow** this official notice board.

For all changes, "Implementing Measures" will be issued by the Rally Directorate and posted on the official notice board.

After withdrawing from the rally, the competitor is obliged to submit a control card in the next TC or to announce this fact to the control room.

After submitting the report or notice of resignation, the crew is obliged to remove the start number from the vehicle.

In categories C, D and MOTO, the rider chooses the driving average himself and reports it while administrative acceptance. Other categories have a driving average set. This driving average is valid for the entire duration of the rally except for the special measured sections.

Explanations of abbreviations

- TC time control
- PC check point control
- MS measured section

Designation of habitats

All sites will be canceled 15 minutes after the ideal passage of the last vehicle, or after passing all vehicles.

Check point with physical control or controlled by GPS can be placed on the track of each stage.

Special tasks can be placed on the track of each stage.

Before each time control, there is a sign (yellow flag) at a distance of approx. 20 - 50 m. If the vehicle enters the section between the start and the finish of the stage, the crew is obliged to immediately record the time of arrival in the control card.

Waiting, turning and reversing is prohibited in this section

• non-compliance means a penalty of 100PP

Penalties

• deviation (+, -) 0.01 sec / 1 PP

Penalties for traffic violations and speeding:

For the whole duration of the rally, the driver must have a valid driver's license and must comply with Czech traffic regulations. Any violation will be reported to the Director of the rally.

- In the case of the 1st offense, with the exception of speeding the penalty be considered by the director of the rally
- $\bullet\,$ For the 2nd offense, with the exception of speeding a point penalty of 150 PP
- $\bullet\,$ For the 3rd offense, with the exception of speeding exclusion from the rally

Exceeding the speed limit during the rally leads to penalty by the rally director as follows:

•	for 1 . speeding	20PP/1 km/h
•	for 2. speeding	40PP/1 km/h
•	for 3. speeding	60PP/1 km/h
•	any further speeding	disqualification
•	for speeding more than 40 km/h	disqualification

Example:

```
speed limit = permitted speed (km/h) + 10% (speed limit 50 km/h + 10% = 55 km/h, speed above this value will be penalized)
```

GPS

All vehicles will be equipped with a GPS unit supplied by the organizer at the administrative check. The crew is required to have the unit located in the vehicle throughout the event followed by the instructions of the event organizers. Without this unit, the vehicle will not be admitted to the technical scrutineering.

During the rally it is forbidden to use GPS devices, except GPS supplied by the organizer.

Each participant shall sign a declaration of non-use of other GPS units at the technical scrutineering. The organizer is entitled to carry out inspections during the entire rally.

Violation of this prohibition means disqualification!

Control cards

The crew will always receive a control card at the first time control
of the day

TC 1. TC 3, TC 6

- Starts in the order and time according to the official start list in minute intervals
- Start with the engine at rest.
- The competitors will calculate the running time of the next TC according to the determined running average speed and round the result to the next higher whole minute

TC 2, TC 5, TC 8

 Early arrival to the time control is allowed 15 min before the ideal time of the 1st car. The crew will find these times in the rally itinerary.

TC 4, TC 7

Early arrival to the time control is NOT allowed.

Measured sections MS 1 - MS 15:

- The start is marked with a white flag.
- The end of the section is marked with a blue flag.
- The crew will pass the MS in the time specified by the organiser.
 The crew will find the designated time in the rally itinerary.
- Entry into the MS is possible at the earliest 15 minutes before the ideal time of the 1st car. The crew will find these times in the rally itinerary.
- All MSs are driven through a flying start and finish point.

Special tasks ZU 1 - ZU 5

- They are not counted in the overall results.
- · Scored separately regardless of category.
- Entry to ZU is possible no earlier than 15 min before the ideal time of the 1st car. The crew will find these times in the rally itinerary.

Adjustment of driving time (adding time for lunch break, completing MS, ZU etc.)

TC 1 \rightarrow TC 2 - calculated time + 20 min

TC 3 \rightarrow TC 4 - calculated time + 10 min

TC 4 → TC 5 - calculated time + 110 min

TC 6 \rightarrow TC 7 - calculated time + 15 min

TC 7 \rightarrow TC 8 - calculated time + 100 min

14. EVALUATION

- Loss, non-submission of control card disqualification
- The winner in each category will be determined by the amount of penalty points.

Absolute winner

The achieved penalty points are multiplied by the coefficient:

MOTO category 1.0

category C 1.1

category D 1.2

category E 1.3

category F 1.4

category G 1.5

The absolute winner is the competitor with the lowest amount of PP. In case of equality of PP winner is a competitor with an older vehicle. In case of the same age of the vehicle, smaller engine capacity will win.

Publication of results

- 1st day on Friday 3. 9. 2021 at 7:30 on the official board
- 2nd day on Saturday 4. 9. 2021 at 7:30 on the official board
- The final unofficial results will be published on Saturday 4. 9. 2021 at 19:00 on the official board
- Final officially results (after any protests) will be published on Saturday, 4. 9. 2021 at 19:30 on the official board

Protests:

If some competitor feels affected by a circumstance during a rally, he may raise a question to the clerk of event within 30 minutes of publication final unofficial results of each day. If the explanation to the competitor is not satisfying, competitor has the right to complain a written protest addressed to the hands of the rally director within 30 minutes, evidenced by a deposit of CZK 4,000 or \in 150.

THERE IS NO POSSIBILITY TO COMPLAIN AGAINST MEASURED TIME In case of protest, the English version of the "Competition rules and Scoring regulations" is valid.
