1. ORGANIZATION AND DESCRIPTION

2. APPLICATION FORM

2.1 Number of applications

Maximal number of accepted applications – 65

2.2 Classified categories

Category C, D, E, F, G, H, I, J1, J2

2.3 Conditions of participation

The competition is open to a two-member crew, where the driver owns a driver's license and the minimum age of the navigator is 16 years. Both must then hold a driver's license issued by the relevant ASN, in the case of czech crews by Autoklub ČR. So-called daily licenses are also accepted, which can only be obtained during the administrative acceptance before the start

2.4 Application

All crews who want to participate must properly fill in the application form, which is at www.oldtimerrally.cz. The application will be accepted if it is properly filled to 31.7. 2021 and the starting fee will be paid.

2.5. Starting fee

Applications send till 15. 6. 2021 – 5200 CZK

Applications send after 15. 6. 2021 – 6400 CZK

3. ADMINISTRATIVE CHECK

3.1 Documents to present

Application form confirmation

Driving licence of the driver

Driver and co-driver licence

ID Card – FIA HTP, TPHV, FIVA card

Certificate of the vehicle registration

Certificate of the vehicle insurance

4. TECHNICAL SCRUTINEERING

Time for the technical check will be prescribed in the application form confirmation. Each vehicle has to have a valid Reg. No. or extraordinary Reg. No. and has to be capable to the traffic flow in ČR and has to comply with FIA HTP, TPHV, FIVA card.

5. MARKING OF CARS

The organizer will provide the crew a rally shield, 2 pieces of start numbers measuring 55x40 cm. A reproduction of the national flag and the names of both crew members must be placed on both front fenders. The minimum height of the flag and font is 4 cm. (provided by the crew - in case of non-compliance, the crew will not be allowed to start.)

6. RALLY COURSE

6.1 Start of the rally

The start of the rally will be on Thursday, September 2, 2021 at 3:00 pm in Mladá Boleslav. Starting interval for all days is 1 minute. Crews arrive at the start zone 3 minutes before their prescribed time.

6.2 Arrival into the finish of the stages

Early arrival at the intermission destinations (lunch break etc.) is NOT ALLOWED.

Early arrival at the finish of each days is NOT ALLOWED.

After passing the finish line of the day, the crew will leave according to the organizers' instructions

7. BASIC RALLY RULES

The official notice board will be placed in the rally headquarters. All competitors are **required to follow** this official notice board

For all the changes will be issued “implementing measures” by the Rally central office, which will be posted on the official notice board.

After retirement the participant is obliged to hand over the control card in the following time control or inform the dispatching

After the hand over of the control card, the crew is obliged to remove the starting number of the vehicle.

Explanation of abbreviations

- TC – time controll
- PC - checkpoint
- MS – measured section
- PP – penalty point

Sites indication

- start of the stage (TC) - Czech flag
- checkpoint (PC) - green flag
- measured section (MS) start - white flag
- measured section (MS) finish - blue flag
- signal before finish of the stage - yellow flag
- finish of the stage (TC) - checkered flag

All sites will be closed 15 minutes after the due time of the last vehicle or after passing all vehicles.

Transit checkpoints with physical control or controlled by GPS can be placed on the track of each stage.

On the route of each leg can be placed special tasks.

In front of every time control there is a signal (yellow flag) in distance of ca. 20 - 50 meters. If the vehicle enters the section between the signal and finish of the

stage, the crew is obliged to let immediately enter the arrival time (done by time keeper) into the control card.

In this area it is prohibited to wait, turn around or reverse

- default is followed with penalty 100PP

Penalizace

Early or late start in any stage	10 PP/min
Not starting within 30 sec	10 PP
No start in any stage	disqualification
No appearance at start of the day within 15 min. of the start time	disqualification
No passing through the finish of the stage	disqualification
Missing any measured section	400 PP
Missing, no marking of control card in PC	500 PP
Not completing the special task	400 PP
Not keeping on the track	100 PP
Early arrival to the TC	20 PP/min
Late arrival to the TC	10 PP/min
Blocking of arrival to the TC	100 PP
Repeated blocking of arrival to the TC	1000 PP
Not allowed person in the car	1000 PP

Měřený úsek (MS):

The measured section can be placed anywhere on the track. The beginning is marked with a white flag - the end of the section is marked with a blue flag. The measured section will be passed by the crew at a time determined by the organizer. The crew will find the specified time in the rally itinerary. All World Championships pass through a flying start and finish point.

Penalties

- **deviation (+,-) 0,01 sec/1 PP**

Penalties for violating traffic regulations and speed limits:

For the entire duration of the rally, the driver must have a valid driver's license and must comply with traffic regulations in force in the Czech Republic. Any violation will be reported to the Rally Director.

- In the case of the 1st offense, with the exception of speeding, punishment at the discretion of the director

- For the 2nd offense, with the exception of speeding, a point penalty of 150 PP awarded by the rally director
- For the 3rd offense, with the exception of speeding, exclusion from the rally

Exceeding the speed limit during the rally leads to punishment by the rally director as follows:

- for the 1st exceeding of permitted speed 20PP/1 km/h
- for the 2nd exceeding of permitted speed 40PP/1 km/h
- for the 3rd exceeding of permitted speed 60PP/1 km/h
- any further exceeding of permitted speed exclusion from rally
- exceeding the speed by more than 40 km/h exclusion from rally

Example:

speed limit = permitted speed (km / h) + 10%

(eg speed limit 50 km / h + 10% = 55 km / h., speed above this value will be penalized)

GPS

All vehicles will be equipped with a GPS unit supplied by the organizer at the administrative check. The crew is obliged to have the unit located in their vehicle for the entire duration of the competition according to the organizer's instructions. Without this unit, the vehicle will not be admitted to the technical scrutineering. During the rally it is forbidden to use GPS devices, except GPS supplied by the organizer.

Each participant will sign a declaration of non-use of these GPS devices during the scrutineering. The organizer is entitled to carry out an inspection during the entire rally. **Violation of this prohibition means disqualification!**
